Dear Parents:

As we begin the 2016-2017 School Year I wanted to make you aware of changes we have made which will affect the bus routing at Tanglewood Elementary School and Central Intermediate School. Buses will now be picking up students from both schools as they run their routes in the mornings. The advantages of this procedure are:


- 1) Fewer stops and pick ups by individual buses. A full bus load of students will be realized more quickly and students will spend less time on the bus.
- 2) Students from both schools will be picked up at the same time making it easier for parents to monitor their children and see them off to school.
- 3) Reduces the number of buses going in and out of neighborhoods.

In the afternoons buses will divide pick up times between the two schools. This will allow for:

- 1) Reduced traffic congestion in the afternoons.
- 2) Buses to begin dropping off students at homes closer to the schools and students will spend less time on the bus.

The starting and dismissal times of the schools will not change. We are prepared to address questions and issues rapidly as they develop. In order to specifically address the issues at these two schools we will have a dedicated phone line in our office. The number is 906-4145. Someone will be working the phones during the day. Please call this number if there is a bus issue or question which needs to be addressed. The issues and questions will be dealt with quickly, and information provided to you.
